



P&I Training Intensive – Recording and planning for serious incidents – Risk assessing and behaviour plans.

Programme Aim

The overall aim of this 2 - hour programme is to give staff an in depth look at techniques to record incidents of a serious nature as well as reflecting on our recordings and how to use them as a basis to risk assess for future incidents.

The aim is that staff will understand the legal guidance around recording and the importance of planning for future incidents. The planning phase is integral to allow us to follow Dfe guidance to reduce the amount of serious interventions that staff are involved in.

On completion the staff will have a clear understanding of

Recording techniques

Reflecting techniques

Risk assessing/planning techniques

Programme statement

Recording, reflecting and planning are often understated tools to the promotion of good behaviour management. Guidance tells us that we should always have plans in place to reduce the number of serious incidents that staff are involved in. Appropriately documenting cycles of behaviour will then allow us to look at trigger patterns. Identifying triggers and preventing incidents from occurring is exactly where this programme is beneficial to staff.

Delivery

The programme is delivered as part of a holistic approach to behaviour management. Delivered with humour and using scenarios from actual incidents we can re-create how staff actually feel during moments of crisis.
